

Guidelines for Use of MUSC Breast Pumping Rooms

MUSC supports your decision to breastfeed and express milk for your baby while you are at work. We are working on improving our employee breast pumping support program,. Currently, there are 3 breast pumping rooms available for staff to share with patients and families. Please review the pump room guidelines and sign below. A MUSC Lactation Consultant will provide you with one breast pump kit to fit the pumps in the hospital.

1. Patients and families come first when waiting to use the pump rooms.
2. Please wipe the breast pump with Cavicide wipes before and after use to decrease the risk of infection from one woman to another.
3. Please clean up after you use the pump room. If pump rooms are left dirty or trashy, staff will not be allowed to use the pump rooms.
4. Remove all your pump parts when you leave including the tubing and cups inside the pump. Pieces that are left behind should be thrown away by the next person.

The breast pump rooms available at this time are in the NNICU area on 8th floor of Children's Hospital and next to the PCICU waiting room on the 4th floor of the main hospital. Please indicate which room you plan to use so your manager can arrange badge access into the room.
